BCC MISSION: To enrich the lives of blind and visually impaired adults preparing them for a normal, active life in a society that is principally sighted by encouraging independence.

The Blind Community Center of San Diego gives blind and visually impaired people in our community an opportunity to socialize and interact. It helps members build skills, confidence and self-esteem through our various, social, recreational and educational, activities. Beginning in June, we are phasing in on-site craft classes and continuing virtual experiences where participants can join by telephone and/or computer.

CLASSES:

The Blind Community Center of San Diego has in-person classes on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. We have virtual classes on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. We have Water Ski and Surf events. Please call for a reservation.

Our first priority is to protect our members, participants, and volunteers. Therefore, we have implemented the following mandatory procedures for in-person classes:

- N95 or KN95 face masks at all times no exceptions.
- Mandatory vaccinations and boosters for everyone, must show proof. No exceptions – Pease don't ask.
- Temperatures will be taken
- Sign up for class by calling the BCCSD at 619-298-5021 and leave a message on ext. 206 at least one week before the class you want to attend.
- If you do not receive a confirmation callback two days before your class, please call Christie at (619) 997-8058.
- No one allowed entry if not on the daily reservation list.
- In person and virtual classes are listed below.
- Everyone needs to schedule their ride home by 1:00 p.m. We realize that MTS has a window around departure times.
- Everyone will receive a to-go lunch as they leave the building.

These procedures may seem extreme, but they are temporary and will change as conditions change. We thank everyone in advance for their patience and cooperation to make the BCCSD a safe place to have fun.

Please note that these Blind Community Center of San Diego guidelines and policies may be subject to change based on latest COVID-19 cases and/or updates from the CDC, Cal OSHA, state or local authorities.

There is an Aira reward program at Starbucks:

A new program, Aira Points, is our first loyalty and reward program and it began on June 7, 2022. Explorers can earn Aira Points every time you use Aira at Starbucks. You need to have the Aira app on your phone and you need to sign up for the Aira Points program.

Get Starbucks to Get More Starbucks!

Simply use Aira at any Starbucks location in the United States, and you will earn Aira Points. Once your Aira Points total reaches a certain amount, you will be able to redeem it for a reward.

This is a pilot program that will run from June 7, 2022 through December 31, 2022. The only way to earn Aira Points is to use Aira at Starbucks. Enthusiastic response from Explorers may lead us to rolling out a formal Loyalty and Rewards Program in 2023 with a variety of Aira Access Partners.

Here is what you need to know to get started:

1. You must sign up for the program between June 7 and July 31.

2. There is no relationship between this program and the Starbucks Rewards program.

3. You can earn points by using Aira at any Starbucks in the US between June 7, 2022 to December 31, 2022.

4. Accumulated points can be redeemed for a reward.

5. Aira will track and reconcile points at the end of each month, beginning on June 30th and ending on December 31st.

6. Aira will send an Aira Points summary via email, to the email address used to sign up for the program, at the end of each month.

7. Aira Points activity WILL NOT be available in the Aira app.

1. 50 points when you sign up for the Aira Points program (requires providing your name, email address and phone number to Aira.)

2. 100 points when you kick start your account by making the first call from a Starbucks.

3. 20 points for each subsequent call from a Starbucks.

4. 20 points for shopping on Starbucks.com with an Aira Agent.

5. 100 points when you make 4 or more separate visits to Starbucks within a one-month period during the program. (Separate visits defined as being a minimum of 3 hours apart.)
