Spotlight on Pat Newman: A Legacy of Friendship and Fun at BCCSD





If you've spent any time at the Blind Community Center of San Diego (BCCSD), chances are you've met Pat Newman. A longtime member and passionate cribbage player. Pat's connection to the Center spans decades, full of stories, service, and heartfelt memories.

Pat's journey began in 1962, when, at age 20, she joined the U.S. Navy. She was stationed at the Naval Training Center (NTC) in San Diego—what we now know as Liberty Station. Within just three months of arriving, she discovered BCCSD. Though she wasn't blind herself, the kindness of the Center's community left a lasting impression on her. One of her earliest memories is how the wonderful people at BCCSD transformed *Mary Poppins* into a six-book braille series for her blind sister, Valerie.

Though life took her in other directions for the next 40 years, Pat never forgot the generosity she experienced. One day, she decided to return—and she's been part of the heart and soul of BCCSD ever since.

Pat brought more than just fond memories back with her. With her deep love for cribbage, she invented a special cribbage board designed for people who are blind or visually impaired. She added braille playing cards and uniquely designed pegs, creating a fully accessible game experience. Since then, Pat has been teaching cribbage with enthusiasm, making the game both inclusive and fun for all. Beyond cribbage, Pat has been a steady presence in nearly every corner of the Center. She has participated in our Blind Singers group, supported water activities, attended countless fundraisers, and—most importantly—built enduring, beautiful friendships. Pat holds the unique distinction of being connected to the Center longer than anyone else. "The BCCSD has been such a huge, wonderful part of my life," Pat shares. "I cherish the friendships, the activities, and the amazing people I've met here." And while Pat is not yet 100 years old, she laughs and admits, "Sometimes it feels like I am!" Thank you, Pat, for your decades of dedication, joy, and creativity. You've helped make the BCCSD the vibrant, welcoming community it is today.
