THE WHOLE STORY

Our Elevator:

- It is Safe and fully operational
- We have quarterly maintenance checkups
- It goes down occasionally 4 outages since
 October 2024 Not due to aging parts
- It is 26 years old and many parts are not available.
- If unavailable parts break, they must be manufactured, which can take weeks.
 - ADA Requirements: Buildings with three or more stories are required to have an operational elevator to provide accessibility.



- In the event of a major repair, the BCCSD and the LOVC will be closed during the repairs.
- Upgrade proposal: \$115,000.
- We are discussing options to repair/replace obsolete components at separate occasions to spread out impact.
